ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BE IT KNOWN, that the undersigned, all of whom being residents of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and citizens of the United States, and all of full age, having associated themselves together for the purpose of organizing The Anthracite Historic Site and Museum, and being desirous of becoming incorporated in accordance with the provisions and requirements of the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania known as the "Nonprofit Corporation Law," approved May 5, 1933 as amended, do hereby declare, set forth and certify as follows:

- 1. That the name of the corporation is The Anthracite Historic Site and Museum and that said name has been registered with the Department of State within Six (5) months of the date of the application for this charter as evidenced by the certificate of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of State attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. That the location and post office address of its initial registered office in this Commonwealth is Mezzanine, Northeastern Building, Hazleton, Luzerne County, Pennsylvania.
- 3. The purpose or purposes of the corporation are: to promote an interest in the history of the Anthracite region of Northeastern Pennsylvania and the development of the Anthracite industry; to foster an interest in the history of the ethnic groups who pioneered in the development of the region and the industry; to collect, construct, and reconstruct the artifacts and historic

sites that are connected with the industry and the region;
to promote, develop and maintain a museum or museums and village
or villages in connection therewith; and in connection with such
purposes to own, acquire, hold, maintain, improve, sell, mortgage
and otherwise deal with real and personal property in such a
manner as will be necessary to carry out the purposes of this
organization.
